The general nature of the business to be conducted under the licence is as a tavern. The days on which and the hours during which alcohol is sold under the licence are Su to Th 8am to 10.30pm, Fr & Sa 8am to 12am, New Year's Eve 8am to 1am. No change to the licensed hours or licensed area is sought. The variation of conditions is sought to allow the deck area to be undesignated up until 9pm. This will allow minors to dine in the area. They will also be able to access bathrooms and enter/exit the premise. (Currently unless they are with a parent or legal guardian this is prohibited). The rest of the premise will remain supervised and after 9pm the entire premise will be supervised. This is in line with the Provisional LAP for Auckland which allows for undesignated areas in taverns for dining areas. This area is used principally for dining. There is no change to the licensed hours. (Online notice 27/11/20).

No objection to the variation of a licence may be made in relation to a matter other than a matter specified in section 105(1) of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. No objection to the renewal of a licence may be made in relation to a matter other than a matter specified in section 131 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.
