2nd Notices (1st was 16/12/21) Toby's Restaurant and Bar - The Three Tobys Ltd has made an application to the District Licensing Committee at Auckland for the renewal of and to vary the hours, licensed area and conditions of an On Licence in respect to the premises situated at 120 Park Rd, Titirangi. The general nature of the business to be conducted under the licence is as a restaurant & functions. The days on which and the hours during which alcohol is currently sold from the premises are Mo to Su 2pm to 12am. The days on which and the hours during which alcohol is intended to be sold under the licence are Interior & Rear deck: Mo to Su 8am to 1am; Exterior: Mo to Su 8am to 12am. It is intended to alter the licensed area to include the entire building and rear deck and to increase the front exterior, which is shown on a plan accompanying the application. The variation of conditions is sought to include function activity to the licence. (Online notice 8/12/21).

No objection to the variation of a licence may be made in relation to a matter other than a matter specified in sections 102(4) & (4A) or 105(1) of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. No objection to the renewal of a licence may be made in relation to a matter other than a matter specified in section 131 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.
