The general nature of the business to be conducted under the licence is as a winery (paid tastings), restaurant, function centre & cellar door. The days on which and the hours during which alcohol is currently sold under the On Licence are Restaurant, Motukaha Room, The Verandah, & Paid Wine Tastings: Su & Mo 11am to 11pm, Tu to Sa 11am to 12am; Alfresco Dining Area, delineated outdoor area & Motukaha Deck: Mo to Sa 11am to 10pm, Su, Xmas Day, Good Fri & Easter Mon 11am to 6pm; Private Functions: Su & Mo 11am to 11pm, Tu to Sa 11am to 12am; Wedding Area: 30 times per calendar year, of which no more than 20 times during November to March (inclusive) for wedding ceremonies only, from 15 mins prior to any wedding ceremony commencing to 30 mins after the ceremony but only on the following days and hours: Mo to Su 11am to 6pm; under the Off Licence are Mo to Su 10am to 5pm. It is intended to alter the licensed area by redefining and merging the licensed footprints so they are the same for both licences which is shown on a plan accompanying the application. It is intended that the days on which and the hours during which alcohol will be sold from this area under the On Licence are Restaurant, Motukaha Room, The Verandah, & Paid Wine Tastings: Su & Mo 11am to 11pm, Tu to Sa 11am to 12am; Alfresco Dining Area, delineated outdoor area & Motukaha Deck: Mo to Sa 11am to 10pm, Su, Xmas Day, Good Fri & Easter Mon 11am to 6pm; Private Functions: Su & Mo 11am to 11pm, Tu to Sa 11am to 12am; Wedding Area: 30 times per calendar year, of which no more than 20 times during November to March (inclusive) for wedding ceremonies only, from 15 mins prior to any wedding ceremony commencing to 30 mins after the ceremony but only on the following days and hours: Mo to Su 11am to 6pm; under the Off Licence are Mo to Su 10am to 5pm. No objection to the variation of a licence may be made in relation to a matter other than a matter specified in section 102(4) & (4A) or 105(1) of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. No objection to the renewal of a licence may be made in relation to a matter other than a matter specified in section 131 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.
